

Medical Biotechnology FAQs for foreign students

When do the courses start?

The first semester starts on the first Monday of October. The second semester on the first Monday of March. In any case, we strongly recommend arriving in Italy at least 15 days in advance to carry out all the necessary paperwork.

How can I find accommodation?

How can I get a scholarship?

The Federico II University **does not directly** provide scholarships. The regional agency Adisurc takes care of them. All the information is on the website (in English): <https://www.adisurcampania.it/scholarships>

How can I reach the Faculty of Biotechnology?

The best way to reach the Faculty of Biotechnology is the subway (Line 1). The "Policlinico" stop is a five-minute walk away. The Faculty of Biotechnology can also be reached by bus from the city center.

How much does it cost each academic year?

Non-EU students will pay only a single tax of 16 euros and a regional tax of 140 euros. The Boel can be collected in person at the Secretary office and must be paid at the bank.

Do I have to bring the Permit of Stay to the Secretary?

Yes, as soon as possible. The secretary is located at the ground floor of the Biotechnology building (CESTEV) and it is open to the public each day from 9 to 13, and also on Tuesday and Thursday from 14 to 16.

How can I get the Unina student email address?

The email will be automatically assigned few days after the enrollment process is completed.

How do I get the tax code?

It is not provided by the Federico II University but by the Questura when the application for the residence permit is presented. The International welcome desk may help you in obtaining the Fiscal code.
